Although this dumpster is being provided to you at no charge, it is a costly service which is made costlier by people who abuse the service, and who ignore the directive from Waste Management as to what is permissible to dump (ex.: mattresses) for which we are assessed additional fees. We plan to continue to offer this service to our residents - Please be considerate and do the right thing so you don't ruin this for everyone else!

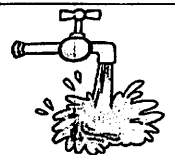
REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR ALL RECREATION VEHICLES WHICH YOU WISH TO REMAIN IN THE PARK. As you are aware, any resident who currently has a recreational vehicle, trailer, box trailer, etc. which they wish to keep in our community MUST register same with our office. Any vehicles not registered with our office no later than Aug. 20, 2017 will not be able to remain in the park.

We were able to convince the park owner to allow for vehicles that are currently here to remain as long as they were registered and complied with the parking requirements, etc. We did our part to assist you in this rule change, now we ask that you do your part. Please provide information as requested!

UPPER AND LOWER PARK WATER LINE FLUSHING will take place July 7th. We will begin flushing lines @ 8 AM. You will have water, but it might be discolored for a short period of time so we suggest that you do not do laundry that day until your water runs clear.



If your water is discolored, run cold water for 5 min., shut off for 30 min. and repeat the process until clear.
